(Graduating High School Seniors)

The Tom Cali Memorial Reach for the Stars Scholarships will present up to two scholarships for \$500 each to graduating seniors. Preference given to students who intend to pursue a major or minor in a two-year or four-year performing arts (acting, directing, design, technical, dance, vocal, instrumental performance, teacher of the performing arts, video/film production, or management) curriculum.

Qualifications:

- Student must have a current membership status with CTH (this will be verified with the CTH membership chairperson).
- Student must have participated significantly in CTH productions during their high school years.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Student must have been already accepted into a 2-year or 4-year college/university. Preference will be given to students who intend to pursue a 2-year or 4-year major or minor in the performing arts post high school.

Application and supporting materials are due by Saturday, May 4, 2024.

Applications will be reviewed by the CTH Awards Committee with recipients chosen and notified via email from scholarships@cththeatre.org.

- Student must complete an official application form (download from www.cththeatre.org/scholarship under tabs About> Scholarship).
- Student must submit a 250 word essay on the following topic when applying for this scholarship: How has participation in CTH affected your life and influenced your plan for your future career?
- Student must submit two letters of recommendation (only one of which can come from a current CTH board member).
- Student must submit a transcript of high school courses and cumulative GPA.
- Student must submit a copy of an acceptance letter from the college/university you will be attending in the fall.

Award:

A check will be presented by a CTH board member to the award-winning student(s) at the CTH All-Stars Event. Scholarship award recipients will be invited to attend to accept their award. Scholarship award winners must write a thank-you letter addressed to the theatre that will be shared with our donors. Details will be provided to scholarship award recipients.
